CENTRAL VALLEY WYE - COMMUNITY OPEN HOUSE

The California High-Speed Rail Authority invites you to attend a community open house to learn more about the proposed alignment alternatives under consideration and next steps for the Central Valley Wye.

The Central Valley Wye is located near Chowchilla and proposes to serve as a junction for the high-speed rail system to head West to San Francisco, North to Sacramento and South to Fresno and the Los Angeles Basin. It will include approximately 50 miles of track running in the three legs of the wye.

The Authority has been working with residents, stakeholders and regulatory agencies to refine the alignment alternatives for the Central Valley Wye. This is an opportunity to ask questions and provide comments about alignment alternatives that will be studied as part of a draft Merced to Fresno High-Speed Rail Project supplemental environmental document.

Some property owners recently received materials regarding a Permit to enter property to conduct environmental surveys. If you received a “PERMIT TO ENTER” letter and have any questions or concerns, please bring it to one of the meetings where staff will be on hand to answer questions.
